

MAKE A ROCK-WALLABY

FRIENDS OF THE BRUSH-TAILED ROCK-WALLABY

Follow the steps below to create a little brush-tailed rock-wallaby for yourself!

MATERIALS

- cardboard inside of a toilet-paper roll
- print-out of the rock-wallaby cut-out template
- Scissors
- Glue



STEPS

- 1. Glue the large rectangular body piece around the outside of the toilet paper roll, covering the tube
- 2. Glue on the head, sticking the lower part of the head to the top of the body so that the tip of the head and the ears stick out
- 3. Glue the pouch on, and stick the joey's head just above it, with the bottom half of its head stuck over the pouch
- 4. Glue on the arms, one on each side of the head, sticking down the rectangular end
- 5. Glue the feet on either side of the body, sticking down the rectangular tabs at the end so that the feet just touch the ground
- 6. Fold out the tabs at the end of the tail, then fold the tail it half and glue either side together, leaving the tab alone. Stick the tab on either side of the tail to the main body
- 7. If you want, draw on a face for the wallaby or its joey
